

Rules for Soccer

Recess and Lunch

School soccer is recreational and noncompetitive. Those wanting to play competitive soccer need to do so through a community league.

The following rules will be enforced:

- **No** hand balls
- **No** carrying soccer balls (other than goalie and they are expected to return the ball to play as quick as possible)
- **No** tackling
- **No** slide tackling
- **No** fancy footwork that can lead to injury or falls
- **No** body contact of any kind (i.e. pushing, shoving, kicking, etc.)
- **No** screaming, yelling or bossing each other
- **Any** disputes between one or more will result in **all** parties receiving a penalty
- **Any** arguing with referee will result in game ejection (for any reason)
- **Any** violence will result in player being immediately brought to office

Anyone not following the rules will be given a penalty as described below:

First penalty: 3 minutes standing by the noon hour referee

Second penalty: 5 minutes standing by the noon hour referee

Third penalty: Game ejection for the remainder of that day.

Anyone receiving three game ejections will not be allowed to play soccer for one week or longer.
