Principal's report to PAC

Thank you to all our parents for your support as we begin another school year!

Staffing: As you have heard, there are teacher shortages which are impacting the school districts across BC and Canada. Div. 14, Grade 4/5 is currently staffed by a TOC, Mr. Glenn until Nov. 6 when Maryse Bonneau will take over until Madame Rodriguez returns in early December. It literally is taking a village to inject French language instruction into the class, and we are so grateful to all who have stepped up to help with this both in our district, our parent community and our staff. Mr. Glenn is an experienced teacher and has built a wonderful, caring, engaged classroom community with the students. He has travel plans for Nov. We are so grateful he agreed to stay with the class until then.

Enrolment: 450 students across 20 divisions, very much the same enrolment as last year. Our classrooms are quite full.

Parking lot and the Pick up lanes: Are working smoothly for the most part. We are asking families to always pull as far forward as they can, parents stay in the vehicle, kids exit quickly. This is the boot and scoot lane. Parents should not be parking in the staff parking at all. And we are asking families to not walk through the staff parking lot at the start and end of the day but use the sidewalk or paved area by the gaga ball pit. It is not safe for anyone to be walking through the parking lot.

By-law has been driving by and ticketing those parking illegally. For example, directly opposite the school bus loop on Sandy Hill road. This is a no stopping, no parking zone and is clearly marked with signage.

Truth and Reconciliation week: Our students are all engaged in learning about residential schools. It is our collective responsibility as educators to work actively to teach about the ongoing impact of residential schools on Indigenous children who did not make it home, survivors and their families. As we know from Justice Murray Sinclair, chair of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, education got us into this mess, education will get us out. Calls to action 62 and 63 are directly related to education. Standard 9 of the BC College of Teachers, teaching standards calls for educators to weave Indigenous ways of knowing and learning into our everyday curriculum.

Dogs on the grounds: Thank you to all the parents who are cooperating with no dogs on the grounds.

Thanksgiving Food Drive: non perishable food is being collected until Oct. 6 for the food bank.

Parent Teacher Interviews: We are continuing with the format we used for the first interviews on Oct. 18 and 19 with evening conferences on Oct. 19. We are trying to increase parent and student voice and are going to focus these interviews with asking questions of parents and listening to what you can share about your children. There will be opportunities for you to ask the teacher questions as well, but we really want to take this time to learn from parents.
